
This is what a landfill looks like.

The amount we waste

• As of 2011 we waste 1.3 billion tons of food, about one third of the global food production are lost or was. In developed countries much food, waste about 100 kilograms (220 lb) per person a year is wasted at the consumption stage. If we recycle more there wouldn't be as much waste in Paraguay and they might be able to afford alot more things like school, a house and a proper job.
